RE: MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT AND SERVICE DIVISION PLUMBERS LOCAL UNION #1, WAGE RATES, FRINGE BENEFITS AND OTHER PROVISIONS **EFFECTIVE TUESDAY, APRIL 1, 2008**

JOURNEYMEN - MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT AND SERVICE DIVISION LOCAL #1

Effective Tuesday, April 1, 2008, there shall be a wage rate increase of **thirty cents (.30¢) per hour** (column 1) and fringe benefits (.15¢ - Welfare Fund / .30¢ - Vacation & Holiday Fund) increase of **forty-five cents (.45¢) per hour** (column 3), which is a package increase of **seventy-five cents (.75¢) per hour** (column 5) for Journeymen employed in the Mechanical Equipment and Service Division. In addition to the package increase, there shall be a **F.I.C.A. payment** increase of **three cents (.03¢) per hour** (column 3). A new schedule of wage rates, fringe benefits and other provisions follows:

UNION ASSESSMENT CHECK-OFF - 3% of Gross Wages paid to employees in the Mechanical Equipment and Service Division shall be deducted from weekly gross wages. Plus, five cents (.05¢) per hour for the Political Action Committee Fund.

*INDUSTRY ORGANIZING FUND - Ten cents (.10¢) per pay hour shall be dedicated to an Industry Organizing Fund to advance the interests of the Industry.

**ADDITIONAL SECURITY BENEFITS FUND – Twenty-nine cents (.29¢) per hour shall be deducted, after taxes, from weekly wages and sent to the Additional Security Benefits Fund. (All overtime on this .29¢ will be at straight time.)

EXPENSE ALLOWANCE FOR PERSONAL SAFETY ITEMS - Twenty-eight cents (.28¢) per hour shall be paid to employees in the Mechanical Equipment and Service Division for each hour worked (work hour), as an expense allowance to provide the funds for his/her personal safety and health related items. Since this is an expense allowance, it should be paid separate from wages and it should be paid on the same day and at the same time as wages.

OVERTIME - For all work required after the completion of regular or shift work, or on any Saturday, Sunday, Holiday or when an employee is called out of his/her house, the Overtime Rate for Wages will be Time and One-Half (1½). (See Additional Security Benefits Fund Statement Above) All Fringe Benefits and Contributions on overtime work will be at Straight Time.

HELPERS - MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT AND SERVICE DIVISION LOCAL #1

Effective Tuesday, April 1, 2008 for 2nd Year through 5th Year Helpers, there shall be a wage rate increase of **fifteen cents (15¢) per hour** (column 1) and for 2nd Term through 5th Year Helpers, a fringe benefits **(.08¢ - Welfare Fund / .15¢ - Vacation & Holiday Fund)** increase of **twenty-three cents (.23¢) per hour** (column 3). In addition to the package increase, there shall be an additional **Welfare Fund** increase of **thirty-one cents (.31¢) per hour** (column 3) and a **F.I.C.A. payment** increase of **two cents (.02¢) per hour** (column 3) for **2nd Term through 5th Year** Helpers. A new schedule of wage rates, fringe benefits and other provisions follows:

UNION ASSESSMENT CHECK-OFF - 3% of Gross Wages paid to employees in the Mechanical Equipment and Service Division shall be deducted from weekly gross wages. Plus, five cents (.05¢) per hour for the Political Action Committee Fund.

*INDUSTRY ORGANIZING FUND - Ten cents (.10¢) per pay hour shall be dedicated to an Industry Organizing Fund to advance the interests of the Industry.

**ADDITIONAL SECURITY BENEFITS FUND - Fifteen cents (.15¢) per hour shall be deducted, after taxes, from weekly wages for the Additional Security Benefits Fund. (All overtime on this .15¢ will be at straight time.)

EXPENSE ALLOWANCE FOR PERSONAL SAFETY ITEMS - Twenty-eight cents (.28¢) per hour shall be paid to employees in the Mechanical Equipment and Service Division for each hour worked (work hour), as an expense allowance to provide the funds for his/her personal safety and health related items. Since this is an expense allowance, it should be paid separate from wages and it should be paid on the same day and at the same time as wages.

OVERTIME - For all work required after the completion of regular or shift work, or on any Saturday, Sunday, Holiday or when an employee is called out of his/her house, the Overtime Rate for Wages will be Time and One-Half (1½). (See Additional Security Benefits Fund Statement Above) All Fringe Benefits and Contributions on overtime work will be at Straight Time.
