RE: OSHA-10 CARDS - EXPIRATION

Dear Contributor:

OSHA-10 Cards have no expiration date. But Local Law 41/2008, a New York City law requiring workers to have OSHA-10 on "site safety jobs," mandates that the OSHA-10 course be taken within the previous 5 calendar years after the effective date of the law (which was December 2, 2008).

Many Local #1 members took the OSHA-10 course in 2008 and 2009 which means that the 5 year period will lapse later this year or early 2014. We urge Employers to check the date on the OSHA-10 card of their employees to insure compliance with Local Law 41/2008.

REMINDER – The Trade Education Facility provides the OSHA-10 course to Local #1 members at least once a month. Members who want to take the course should call the Local #1 Trade Education Facility at 718-752-9630 to enroll for the next class.
