Dear Sir:

There has been an inquiry regarding whether certain work on the East Side Access project must be performed as plumbing work using members of Plumbers Local Union #1 (e.g. MTA contract CM03A plumbing riser diagram sheet 170, 55th Street Ventilation Facility). Plumbers Local Union #1 advises that they have met with the relevant trade unions (Laborers Local Unions #147 and #731) and are in agreement:

For subway stations and ventilation shafts/facilities -- any area drains, platform drains, sump pumps, ejector pumps, fire lines, Siamese connections, compressed air lines, grease lines, trench drains, trough drains, sanitary lines, water mains, water meters, any kind of plumbing fixtures, and any other lines or systems as stated in the Plumbers Local Union #1 2010-2012 Collective Bargaining Agreement, is the work of the plumber. Track drainage piping in the center line of the track is not the work of the plumber.
