TO: ALL MEMBERS AND PROMOTION FUND CONTRIBUTORS

RE: MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT AND SERVICE DIVISION PLUMBERS LOCAL UNION #1, WAGE RATES, FRINGE BENEFITS AND OTHER PROVISIONS **EFFECTIVE FRIDAY, APRIL 1, 2011**

JOURNEYMEN/SERVICEMEN - MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT AND SERVICE DIVISION LOCAL #1

Effective Friday, April 1, 2011, there shall be a **wage rate** increase of **thirty-five cents (.35¢) per hour** (column 1) and a **fringe benefits (Welfare Fund)** increase of **fifteen cents (.15¢) per hour** (column 3), which is a package increase of **fifty cents (.50¢) per hour** (column 5) for Journeymen employed in the Mechanical Equipment and Service Division. A new schedule of wage rates, fringe benefits and other provisions follows:

UNION ASSESSMENT CHECK-OFF - 3% of Gross Wages paid to employees in the Mechanical Equipment and Service Division shall be deducted from weekly gross wages. Plus, five cents (.05¢) per hour for the Political Action Committee Fund.

**INDUSTRY ORGANIZING FUND - Ten cents (.10¢) per pay hour shall be dedicated to an Industry Organizing Fund to advance the interests of the Industry.

EXPENSE ALLOWANCE FOR PERSONAL SAFETY ITEMS - Twenty-eight cents (.28¢) per hour shall be paid to employees in the Mechanical Equipment and Service Division for each hour worked (work hour), as an expense allowance to provide the funds for his/her personal safety and health related items. Since this is an expense allowance, it should be paid separate from wages and it should be paid on the same day and at the same time as wages.

OVERTIME - For all work required after the completion of regular or shift work, or on any Saturday, Sunday, Holiday or when an employee is called out of his/her house, the Overtime Rate for Wages will be Time and One-Half (1½). All Fringe Benefits and Contributions on overtime work will be at Straight Time.

*SERVICEMEN - The Wage Rate for Servicemen is **\$22.54 Per Hour**. Wages are based on 70% of the Journeymen Wage Rate Per Hour. (Fringe Benefits are based on 100% of the Journeymen Fringe Benefits)

HELPERS - MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT AND SERVICE DIVISION LOCAL #1

Effective Friday, April 1, 2011 for 2nd Year through 5th Year Helpers, there shall be a **wage rate** increase of **eighteen cents (.18¢) per hour** (column 1). For 1st Year, 2nd Term through 5th Year Helpers, a **fringe benefits (Welfare Fund)** increase of **seven cents (.07¢) per hour** (column 3). A new schedule of wage rates, fringe benefits and other provisions follows:

UNION ASSESSMENT CHECK-OFF - 3% of Gross Wages paid to employees in the Mechanical Equipment and Service Division shall be deducted from weekly gross wages. Plus, five cents (.05¢) per hour for the Political Action Committee Fund.

*INDUSTRY ORGANIZING FUND - Ten cents (.10¢) per pay hour shall be dedicated to an Industry Organizing Fund to advance the interests of the Industry.

EXPENSE ALLOWANCE FOR PERSONAL SAFETY ITEMS - Twenty-eight cents (.28¢) per hour shall be paid to employees in the Mechanical Equipment and Service Division for each hour worked (work hour), as an expense allowance to provide the funds for his/her personal safety and health related items. Since this is an expense allowance, it should be paid separate from wages and it should be paid on the same day and at the same time as wages.

OVERTIME - For all work required after the completion of regular or shift work, or on any Saturday, Sunday, Holiday or when an employee is called out of his/her house, the Overtime Rate for Wages will be Time and One-Half (1½). All Fringe Benefits and Contributions on overtime work will be at Straight Time.
